CLUBHOUSE RESTAURANT REOPENS

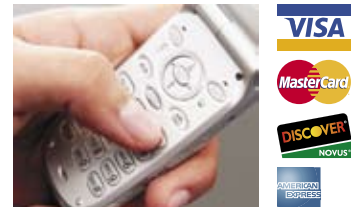

Blue Flag Holders (Handicap Flags) – All flag holders need to park their carts behind the greens complex. This will ensure turf coverage in front and to the sides of all greens for all players. Also as a reminder to keep carts 15 feet from greens and tees. We have received numerous pictures of blue flag players parking on or near the colliers of the greens surfaces. Please for everyone's enjoyment, we ask that everyone follow the blue flag rules and guidelines.

XERISCAPING

Sun 'n Lake has been using xeriscaping to create sustainable community grounds for years. So what is xeriscape ('zer-ə-,skāp)? Originating in Colorado in 1985, xeriscaping refers to a method of landscape design that minimizes water use. Elements of xeriscaping include:

1 Zoning – group plants in the landscape according to their water requirements

2 Use drought tolerant plants – native plants best suited to the climate will require less water and adapt to drought conditions and soils with low water-holding capacities

3 Drought tolerant turf – Ask your local nurseries which grass varieties will grow well in your area. In Florida, centipede grass, bahiagrass, bermudagrass, and zoysiagrass all have excellent drought tolerance. During dry periods, allow the turf to go dormant. When the rain comes, these grasses will turn green again.

4 Mulch – Mulch is used extensively to reduce evaporation. Maintaining a 3-inch layer will help retain soil moisture, prevent erosion and suppress weeds. It can also be used to create walkways through your landscape.
