RECREATION COMPLEX CONSTRUCTION BEGINS



Sun 'n Lake Board of Supervisors, General Manager and representatives from Lodge Construction, Weller Pools and The Evans Group break ground on the new recreation complex

Dirt mountains and construction fencing are visible signs that the new Recreation Complex is underway. Work has begun on the 1,900 square foot Recreation Complex that will feature a lagoon pool with zero entry and water features. The bath house will serve as the gate keeping facility. Outside restrooms, picnic pavilion and children's play areas with specific play equipment for 2 to 5 year olds and 6 to 12 year olds are also part of the project. The Recreation Complex (Phase 1), located behind the Community Center, is scheduled for completion by July 31, 2010. The Community Center will remain open during construction.

AROUND THE GOLF CORNER

Golf Course News – In the next 45 days you will notice that day and night temperatures will begin to rise. This is the time of year to begin transitioning the golf courses from our cool season grass to our warm season grass. There will be some non-aggressive procedures such as verti-cutting, light topdressing and fertilizing the tees, greens, and fairways to allow sunlight to reach the warm season grass which is currently shaded. Over the next few weeks we have contracted a block company to complete the driving range awning project. We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we are in the final stages of completing this project. The club will also be installing a sand bin in the gravel golf cart parking area adjacent to the new putting green and cart barn over the next few weeks.

Night Golf Anyone! – The Golf Staff will be putting on a Night Golf 9-Hole Tournament on March 24th. The format for this event will be a 4-Person Scramble. The cost is \$30.00 for Residents and \$20.00 per golf member. The fee will include golf/cart, 2 glow in the dark golf balls, glow decorations, prizes and more. Pace of Play – At this time of year more members and guests are playing the golf courses, which sometimes increases the average golf round time. Here are a few tips and suggestions that will help you and your guest play in an efficient way. • Plan your shot while others are playing their shot • Line up your putt when others are putting • Be ready when it's your turn • Go directly to your ball while others are going to theirs • Take several clubs to your ball if you're playing partner has the cart • Be efficient with your pre-shot routine • Take only one practice swing • Exit putting green promptly after holing out.
