AROUND THE GOLF CORNER

Golf Course News - Both courses are transitioning smoothly as the maintenance crew begins the necessary agronomic practices of fertilization, verti-cutting, topdressing, spiking and aerification. On 4/30 and 5/1 Deer Run will be closed and on 5/2-3 Turtle Run will be closed for curfew application treatment of insects. Work has begun on the block wall for the driving range awning, as well as a sand bin in the gravel golf cart parking area adjacent to the new putting green and cart barn. The maintenance team is also preparing some areas along the cart paths for new sod. You can help to prevent worn out areas by keeping all tires on the cart path when parking your cart along the greens and tees.

CODE ENFORCEMENT REMINDER

Let's all keep Sun 'n Lake beautiful this summer!

Here are some key ordinances to be aware of:

- The owner of a vacant cleared lot within a residential section of the district shall not allow grass or any other vegetation to grow higher than eighteen (18) inches in height.
- No person shall park any operational motor vehicle in the front yard on any area except the prepared surface. No person shall park any vehicle either behind a structure or to the side of a structure behind the front building line except on a temporary basis.
- Recreational vehicles shall not be located in any front, side or rear yard except that one boat 18 feet or less and no more than six feet high may be parked in a driveway not nearer than 7 ½ feet to any property line.
